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METHODE CAP CLASSIQUE

L'Ormarins Brut N.V. (Franschhoek)

R520

62% Chardonnay 38% Pinot Noir

Vigorous fine bead with green apple, lemon, yeast and fresh sea breeze aromas. The palate echoes those aromatic notes with its crisp lemon freshness and green apple vibrancy that is brushed with grapefruit and citrus zest. A gentle, creamier biscuit and toast note then develops. Elegant and well-structured with good fruit, acidity and lees harmony. The finish is long, dry and crisply detailed.

L'Ormarins Brut Rose N.V. (Franschhoek)

R520

65% Pinot Noir 35% Chardonnay

Coral pink hue with a vigorous stream of fine bubbles. Bold strawberry and red berry fruit on the nose. There's more of this in the mouth – with cherry, strawberry and bold red fruit on entry. The fresh, zesty lemon and citrus zip of acidity adds succulence to the mouthful.

L'Ormarins Blanc de Blanc MCC 2021 (Franschhoek)

R738

Vigorous and lively bubble with trademark string of pearls rising to the surface. Sea spray, lime zest, chalk and subtler aromas of orange peel is present on the nose. The palate is energetic and tangy with abundant crunchy green apple and lime zip on entry. Refined and elegant, it lingers on the aftertaste but never loses its lively youthfulness and seamless integration of fruit, lees and bright acidity.

La Motte Brut N.V. (Franschhoek)

R706

58% Chardonnay 42% Pinot Noir

A vibrant and elegant MCC with expressive aromas of citrus, brioche and roasted cashew. The palate is finely textured with delicate bubbles, refined length and finesse. Notes of lemon meringue linger on the finish, carried by a subtle mineral edge.

Leopard's Leap Cullinaria Brut N.V. (Western Cape)

R524

100% Chenin Blanc

Green in colour. Notes of green pear, Granny Smith apples, lime and grapefruit are all evident on the nose. Fresh minerality on the palate with a biscuit finish.





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CHAMPAGNE

Champagne Baron De Rothschild Brut Rose NV
85%Chardonnay,15% Pinot Noir

R2934

Subtle aromas of spring with fragrances of rose petals, wild strawberries and a hint of citrus zest. A fresh silkiness is found on the palate with slight raspberry undertones, a well-balanced wine with a full long finish.

Champagne Baron De Rothschild Concordia Brut NV
60%Chardonnay, 40%Pinot Noir

R2934

Exceptionally fine cuvee which exudes aromas of pear and nuts which marry hints of white flowers and faint toasty notes

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ROSÉ

Protea Rose 2025 (Western Cape)

R220

Cinsault 70% Mourvèdre 10% Shiraz 6% Grenache 6% Malbec 5% Carignan 3%

Tempting aromas of raspberry, strawberry and ripe red cherries. The palate delivers what the nose promises: ripe, bright red berry fruit. Add crispness from pleasing acidity to the mix along with a dryness that leaves the mouth crisp and clean with a lingering fruit memory. Refreshing and pleasant, it's ideal for summer.

La Motte Rose Vin de Joie 2025 (Franschhoek)

R375

Grenache 69% Mourvèdre 9% Cinsault 4% Shiraz 4%

The nose offers subtle but well-defined melon, rose petal and nectarine with the charming notes of Turkish delight in the background. Refreshing acidity and a lovely lingering nectarine aftertaste

Waterford Rosemary Rose 2025 (Stellenbosch)

R450

Shiraz 35% Tempranillo 20% Malbec 13% Grenache 10% Merlot 9% Cinsault 7% Mourvèdre 4% Sangiovese 1% Barbera 1%

The iconic blush hue of Rose-Mary is a testament to the Blanc de Noir style. Crafted from Mediterranean varietals, the wine shows aromas of delicate white peach and rose water, which seamlessly follow through to the palate. On the palate, layers of white peach, fresh strawberry, and apricot unfold, supported by a refreshing mineral backbone that enhances both texture and balance. Impeccably poised, this wine finishes long and complex, with a purity and elegant finesse that define its character.

De Morgenzon Garden Vineyard Rosé 2023 (Stellenbosch)

R490

Juicy flavours of cherries and strawberries are the characters to be found on the nose. Delicate and floral spice with fruit salad ends in well balanced crisp and dry palate.

Jean Roi Cap Provincial Rose 2025 (Swartland)

R592

Grenache 46% Mourvèdre 32% Cinsault 11% Shiraz 6% Pique Poul Blanc 5%

Soft floral cherry and blueberry nose. The palate is reminiscent of a fruit salad with its apple, melon, berries, cherries and strawberry flavours. All at peak ripeness, rounded but balanced by bright acid. Overall, there is good focus and body with a long, leesy tail that adds another textural nuance



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CHARDONNAY

Protea Chardonnay 2025 (Western Cape)

R220

Understated nose of citrus peel and leaf with floral note on the edges. The wine is rounded with typical gentle citrus and orange flavour, bright and juicy. The palate broadens with a creamy lees element adding to the ripe fruit and marmalade notes. Good breadth, depth and overall harmony. Medium body and length.

La Motte Chardonnay 2024 (Franschhoek)

R506

This wine is made from whole bunch pressed grapes produced exclusively on La Motte, favoured by the Franschhoek Valley's terroir, which is well-known for rendering exceptional Chardonnay. The wine is fermented and matured in French oak barrels, to produce full bodied, fruity wine with subtle oak flavours.

Cape of Good Hope Serruria Chardonnay 2024 (Elandskloof)

R606

Gentle appeal of lemon cream, butterscotch, chamomile and oatmeal with a light floral nuance on the nose. Citrus vivacity lime and lemon is immediately apparent in the mouth. The wine morphs effortlessly and seamlessly into a rich and creamy macadamia-toned multi-layered mouthful. Elegant and confident throughout. Delightful!

De Wetshof Bon Vallon Chardonnay 2025 (Robertson)

R678

Fresh green apples with stone fruit and citrus on the nose. Fruity and mineral tones on the palate finishes of this dry full-bodied wine.

Rupert and Rothschild Baroness Nadine 2024 (Western Cape)



R920

Loads of citrus and nutty notes are found on the nose. A fusion of citrus blossom with macadamia nougat and baguette crust on the palate, followed by a creamy roundness ending in a lingering lemon zest finish.



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SAUVIGNON BLANC

Protea Sauvignon Blanc 2025 (Western Cape) R220

Whiffs of nectarine, peach and tropical fruit with a light hint of gravel. Vivacious and bold in the mouth with bright grapefruit zest and tangy apricot, nectarine and quince fruit flavours. Crisp, dry and clean tail. Ideal for summer.

Leopard's Leap Sauvignon Blanc 2025 (Western Cape) R240

A firm yet elegant structure with fresh, crisp, apple and lime flavours that lead to a zest aftertaste.

La Motte Sauvignon Blanc 2025 (Franschhoek) R384

Grapes from different vineyards are combined to produce this popular varietal wine. This unwooded aperitif-style wine is highly regarded for its distinctive strong gooseberry character backed up by apple, winter melon, lemon and a satisfying structure.

Cape of Good Hope Altima Sauvignon Blanc 2025(Elandskloof) R406

Tropical fig, granadilla and pear bouquet on the nose. Tropical fruits such as fig, gooseberries and lemon zest is characterful on the palate. A well textured wine with a light dry finish.

Tokara Sauvignon Blanc 2024- 2025 (Elgin) R406

The wine has a light straw colour with a brilliant pale green edge that catches the light. There is an appealing mix of lemon sorbet, sweet guava skin and Cape gooseberry on the nose. The wine enters the palate with concentrated flavours, consistent with the aromatics. The finish is refreshing and crisp with a slight oyster shell salinity derived from the grape's provenance on cool, maritime sites.

La Motte Pierneef Sauvignon Blanc 2024 (Cape South Coast) R466

The wine shows layers of intense fruit - green fig, ripe apple and fruit cocktail. The distinctive freshness and minerality reflect the soils and climates of some of the southern-most sites in Africa.

Tokara Reserve Elgin Sauvignon Blanc 2024 (Elgin) R620



Interesting aromas of sea air, quince and nettles are found on the nose. A crisp palate with notes of quince, greengage and guava are found on the palate. The mid palate is rich and mouth filling with a long crisp finish.

Rimapere Sauvignon Blanc 2022 (Marlborough, New Zealand) R1005

Grapefruit and lemon flavours, minerality and intense acidity persistence of citrus aromas. The Rimapere initiative is the result of the alliance between Benjamin De Rothschild and the Peabody Family of New Zealand, which owns Craggy Range Winery

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CHENIN BLANC

Protea Chenin Blanc 2025 (Western Cape)

R220

Apricot and stone fruit aromas also show a light lemon and gravel nuance. The palate is bright and thrilling with crisp acid zip, nicely taut and tangy, balanced by ripe fruit notes of apricot, melon, and quince. There is also a lively lemon zest succulence. Ideal for summer.

Leopard's Leap Chenin Blanc 2025 (Western Cape)

R240

Prominent guava aromas with hints of litchi and mango with herbaceous undertones on the nose. A combination of herbs and ripe summer fruit, with firm acidity with a lingering finish.

Cape of Good Hope Riebeeksrivier Chenin Blanc 2025 (Swartland)

R370

Nectarine, quince and citrus notes mingle on the nose, underpinned by a subtle chalk or hot stone aroma. Harmony and balance are the overriding characteristics of this wine in the mouth. Rich and rewarding, the vibrant fruit – apricot, bright nectarine and poached quince – are subtly framed by creamy oak and a leesy breadth. Balanced and long with a zesty citrus note on the tail.

De Morgenzon Chenin Blanc 2024 (Stellenbosch)

R490

Peaches, honey and toast are prominent on the nose. Intense flavours of pear, orange blossom, caramel and spice explode in your mouth. This wine has the perfect balance of lush fruit and crisp acidity with a long finish.

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WHITE BLENDS

Cape of Good Hope Caroline 2023 (Swartland)

R450



Marsanne 38% Roussanne 22% Piquepoul Blanc 16% Chenin Blanc 14% Viognier 10%

Rhône style white blend with aromatics of stone fruit with a nutty marzipan flavour and hints of oak are apparent too. The palate reflects the time the components of this blend spent in wood with a broad, creamy spiciness that complements the peach, quince, and gooseberry fruit flavours. Lovely texture with good palate weight—the wine promises and delivers an elegant, creamy, long, and enjoyable mouthful.

Cape of Good Hope Groendruif Semillon 2025 (Citrusdal)

R545

95% Semillon 5% Sauvignon Blanc

Citrus aromas with stone fruit, lemongrass and a light dusting of gravel. That same lemon and lemongrass vibrance is found on the palate, which is both bright, taut and tangy. Lively acidity keeps the nectarine, white peach and zesty citrus flavours front and centre, but with a flinty, petrichor edge. Compact and firm, the texture and mouthfeel display a delightful tension that adds to the structure of this young wine. Lovely tension of opposites in its youth but it will evolve, becoming richer and fuller with age and careful cellaring.

Tokara Director's Reserve White Blend 2022 (Stellenbosch)

R1256

73% Sauvignon Blanc 27% Semillon

The nose has the intense aroma of quince, passion fruit and roasted almonds. The oak maturation and the full fruit palate round this well-balanced wine off perfectly. The finish is rich and long.

OTHER WHITE CULTIVARS

Protea Pinot Grigio 2025 (Western Cape)

R220

Light aromas of stone fruit with nectarine and peach blossom to the fore. Fresh fruity and lively entry to the mouth with both peach, crunchy apple and nectarine flavours. That bright, lively tropicality is tempered by good acidity and a light touch of pebble or slate. Good body and length.

Terra del Capo Pinot Grigio 2025 (Stellenbosch)

R235

Lime, peach and nectarine vivacity on the nose. That brightness continues on the palate with crisp nectarine, white peach and quince characters matched by lively balancing acidity. Light bodied and refreshing with a defined, dry finish. The fruit memory lingers.



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RED BLENDS

La Motte Millennium 2023 (Franschhoek) R368

66% Merlot 25% Cabernet Franc 6% Shiraz 3% Petit Verdot

Merlot dominates the Bordeaux style. Lush raspberries with the herbaceous Cabernet Franc and English toffee from oak maturation. Well-rounded and harmonious, ending in a rich, juicy palate.

Terra del Capo Arne 2022 (Stellenbosch) R418

50% Merlot 50% Sangiovese

Plump, black hedgerow fruit with both a subtle tomato plant and spice note, as well as a gentle violet perfume. The palate is structured and generous with the mouthfeel providing an impression of refinement and elegance, as well as generosity and succulence.

Rupert & Rothschild Classique 2022 (Western Cape) R630

Merlot 38% Cabernet Sauvignon 35% Petit Verdot 14% Cabernet Franc 12% Malbec 1%

Inviting and expressive bouquet with aromas of blackcurrant and plum, supported with all spice nuances from maturation. The palate starts out plush with dark fruit and tight-knit tannins. The wine has an elegant and refined structure.

Anthonij Rupert Optima 2021 (Franschoek) R654

37% Cabernet Sauvignon 29% Merlot 28% Cabernet Franc 6% Malbec

Tendrils of spice add nuance and allure to a nose packed with black berries, hedgerow fruit and some mocha notes. The palate is plush, rounded and pillowy but layered with dark fruitcake flavour, black cherry, baking spice and pencil shavings too. Balanced with seamless integration of oak and ripe, rich fruit with lovely succulence and freshness as well. Complex, supple and silky smooth, the wine is ultimately simply delicious with a superbly long tail

Tokara Directors Reserve Red Blend 2021 (Stellenbosch) R1886

70% Cabernet Sauvignon 14% Petit Verdot 10% Merlot 4% Cabernet Franc 2% Malbec

The wine has a vibrant crimson colour with an intense dark centre and a ruby rim. The nose showcases complex aromas of black cherry, subtle cocoa, dried currants, tobacco leaf and graphite. The wine enters the palate with incredible purity and focus, with flavours of dark cherries, blackberries and plum skin. Sumptuous and full there is a hint of tension on the mid-palate which leads to fine dense tannins and a lengthy finish





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RED BLENDS

Rupert & Rothschild Baron Edmond 2021 (Stellenbosch) R1885

Merlot 60% Cabernet Franc 25% Cabernet Sauvignon 15%

Aromas of blackberries and blueberries with a note of fresh coriander. Layers of complexity unfolds on the palate with silky tannins. Exceptional balance, beautifully structured with hints of chocolate.

La Motte Hanneli R 2022 (Franschhoek) R4250

Syrah 64% Petite Sirah 36%

This complex Syrah-based blend is the ideal partner to red meat in most of its forms. With its well-structured tannins, this wine beautifully complements the intensity of hard cheese.

OTHER RED CULTIVARS

Terra del Capo Sangiovese 2023 (Stellenbosch) R306

Tempting traces of caramel and sweet floral aromas can be found with the more prominent spice, cherry and overt blueberry fruit notes. The trademark cherry flavour and succulence is obvious on the palate entry.

Lively, bright and engaging it offers more besides: dark fruitcake and ample spice – cinnamon and nutmeg – alongside an understated oaky nuance. The grape's signature tannins have been held in check and provide a gentle squeeze and light dryness without overwhelming the structure and body, with is nicely lithe and pliable. A deliciously persistent finish rounds off the tasty mouthful

L' Ormarins Ou bosstok Cinsault 2024 (Riebeeksrivier) R820

The wine was fermented in Italian Nico Velo concrete tanks. This unique fermentation vessel enhances complexity and accentuates the natural red fruit flavours characteristic of Cinsault. The wine was left on the malolactic lees for approximately four months in these tanks before being racked into a stainless steel tanks. A small portion of the wine was aged in oak barrels for six months, with just 1% new oak used.



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CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Protea Cabernet Sauvignon 2023 (Franschhoek) R220

Warm appeal of ripe blackberry, cherry and fruitcake aromas. Those same flavours step confidently onto the palate; black cherry, fruitcake and blackberry – with a light brush of herbs and trace of bonfire smoke too. Supple and succulent to the end

Leopard's Leap Cabernet Sauvignon 2024 (Swartland) R224

With lovely undertones of blueberries, mulberries and cassis on the nose. This Cabernet Sauvignon is a quite velvety wine with soft tannins making it easy drinking.

Tokara Cabernet Sauvignon 2023 (Franschhoek) R470

Berry aromas of Cassis, red currant and blueberries on the nose complimented by underlying notes of cocoa, fresh herbs and tobacco spice.

La Motte Cabernet Sauvignon 2023 (Franschhoek) R506

A classic South African Cabernet Sauvignon with an elegant minerality and typical varietal characteristics such as berry and plum flavours and hints of cloves, mint and cigar box. Well-considered barrel maturation and firm but accessible tannins ensure a full-bodied wine with a rich consistency and lingering finish.

Rust en Vrede Cabernet Sauvignon 2022 (Stellenbosch) R1195

Perfumed aromas of lavender, black currant, cedar and vanilla. The palate is lively and expressive, offering layers of black and red cherries, complemented by hints of graphite, espresso, and dark chocolate. Firm, youthful tannins and zesty acidity provide structure, finishing with a lingering note of cherries. An elegant and refined Cabernet.

Anthonij Rupert Cabernet Sauvignon 2021 (Franschhoek) R1890

Leafy hedgerow fruit, graphite, spice and cedar with a tobacco leaf nuance on the nose. Complex and inviting. Riper berry fruit is found in the mouth: cherry, youngberry, blackberry and plums. Pretty in its succulence and pliability. Vibrant spice adds to the complexity. Layered, complex and rich but also elegant and refined

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MERLOT

Protea Merlot 2023 (Western Cape)

R220

100% Merlot

Seductive dark berry compote with attractive spicy highlights on the nose. Rounded, plush and appealing on entry, delivering what the nose promised: plum, mulberry, cherry and blackberry fruit sprinkled with spice. Beautifully poised and integrated, the flavours linger on a long, rewarding finish. Packed with appeal!

Leopard's Leap Merlot 2023 (Swartland)

R240

100% Merlot

Hints of cocoa with red fruit are dominant on the palate. With the soft tannins it's a well-balanced wine with a long finish.

Deetlef's Estate Merlot 2024 (BreedeKloof)

R528

100% Merlot

Intense deep Ruby with a scarlet rim. It has an abundance of black cherry, plum, black currant and raspberry aromas with a hint of spice and dried herbs. The palate is smooth on entry with good structure and weight on the middle palate. Good balance between fruit and oak with dried mulberry and herbs on the finish.

Anthonij Rupert Merlot 2021 (Franschhoek)

R1094

100% Merlot

Bold purple plums, black cherries and perfume with subtle edge of cut flower stems on the nose. The palate is taut, needing a bit of time and air to reveal its strata of spicy purple and black berry fruits. There's an oak edge which lends both spice and structure to the wine while acidity adds freshness and piquancy. Savoury, tangy and tasty with a long tail, it will reward patience.

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SHIRAZ

Protea Shiraz 2024 (Western Cape) R220
100% Shiraz

Waxy plum and blueberry aromatics with tendrils of fynbos and violet. Confident, rounded and appealing mouthful of ripe plum, pepper and dried herbs. Lively and fresh with good succulence.

Leopard's Leap Shiraz 2023 (Paardeberg-Swartberg) R240
100% Shiraz

Deep purple layers of plum and blackberry, intertwined with subtle undertones of cracked black Pepper. Whiffs of clove and coriander create a rich and intense aroma on the nose.

Cape of Good Hope Syrah 2021 (Swartland) R390
100% Syrah

Intriguing blend of black fruit – ripe plum and black cherry – mingled with spice, fynbos, dried herb and olives can be found aromatically. Succulence is the first impression in the mouth – followed swiftly by what the nose promised: the dark, ripe plum flavour, dried herbs, black olive and fynbos along with spice and a creamy, buttery mouthfeel. Superbly balanced, rounded and poised with the fruit in harmony with acid, as well as the oak it has matured in. Long, rewarding tail.

Cape of Good Hope Southern Slopes 2020 (Swartland) R464
Shiraz 94% Mourvedre 3% Viognier 2% Durif 1%

Mix of ripe, dark blue and black berries and plum fruit, brushed with spice and herbs. Succulent entry to the mouth with immediate plump, plush blueberry and plum. Suave, genteel and elegant with a glossy, smoothly varnished long farewell.

La Motte Syrah 2022 (Franschhoek) R552
100% Syrah

Years of experience in producing this varietal have enabled La Motte to combine the grapes of several cool terroirs to capture juicy berry-fruit, sweet liquorice, violet flowers and pepper spice.

La Motte Pierneef Atelier 2020 (Franschoek) R932
93% Syrah 3% Viognier

This unique blend offers perfumy rose petals and the depth of eastern spice on the nose. Voluptuous, but gentle, the palate finishes with intricate layers of liquorice, savoury salami and red peppercorns for a very classic character. The structure and spice of the Syrah as well as the floral nuances of the Viognier make this a very versatile red when it comes to the dinner table.

Waterford Kevin Arnold Shiraz 2020 (Stellenbosch) R1113

Aromas of mulberry, red currants and spices are the dominant bouquet on the nose. The bouquet carries over on to the palate with light hints of oak

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PINOTAGE

Leopard's Leap Pinotage 2022 (Paarl)

R240

An elegant typically South African Pinotage, fruit-driven and well balanced. Red fruit aromas follow through on the palate with bursts of juicy red berries giving a pleasant aftertaste. Matured on 100% Oak staves for 6 to 8 months with added micro-oxygenation. 70% of the oak staves were made from French oak, 20% from American & 10% from Hungarian.

Simonsig Pinotage 2023 (Stellenbosch)

R438

Ripe red fruit notes of cranberry and raspberry dominate, lending a succulent and juicy character to the palate. A delightful twist emerges with the addition of dark fruit nuances, adding depth and complexity. The distinctive South African touch is evident in the spicy fynbos undertones, imparting a unique aromatic quality. The wine is framed by crunchy tannins that provide structure and a textural dimension

PINOT NOIR

Cape of Good Hope Sneeuwkrans Pinot Noir 2021 (Elandskloof)

R870

Typical cherry, plum, spice and forest floor aromas. Light smoke whiff too. A suave, supple and confident mouthful of red berry fruit which combines with smooth, silky texture. Integrated and harmonious with seamless oak and appealing dry spice notes throughout. Impressive length of flavor.

De Wetshof Nature in Concert Pinot Noir 2022 (Robertson)



R1580

Aromas of dark berries and ripe plum are the noticeable notes found on the nose. Full-ripe berries and cherries with a nutty aroma is found on the palate with smooth tannins which makes it an elegant wine.

DESSERT WINE

L'Ormarins Muscat D'Alexandrie 2016 (Western Cape)

R1136

Mesmerising golden incandescent colour. The nose offers trademark of loral Muscat perfume with an intriguing liquorice edge. Then there's honeycomb, sun ripe dried mango and sultana notes too. There's more to the palate than simple rich, honeyed sweetness – which it has in abundance. Subtle macadamia and roasted pecan nuttiness with a cookie dough element can be discerned, along with the ripe sultana fruitiness. Fortification is well handled and although sweet, it's also fresh, beautifully balanced and long.

Leopards Leap Culinaria Natural Sweet Chenin Blanc 2024 (Paarl)

R1198

Tokara Wine Estate was established in 1994 by GT Ferreira, a prominent South African businessman with a passion for wine. Tokara is a family-owned vineyard and derives its name from the founders' children, Thomas and Kara. Tokara winery is situated on the crest of the Helshoogte Pass, about 5km from the historic winemaking town of Stellenbosch.

Welbedacht – pronounced Well-be-duct means well thought in High Dutch and was demarcated in 1830 from the farm Driefontein – meaning three fountains – in the Wellington district. The Burger family acquired Welbedacht in 1997 after also buying the neighboring farm and the two farms form the Welbedacht Wine Estate, which means all the wine must be grown, made and bottled on the Estate.
